Site Selection and Building	Investigating and researching property availability and evaluating suitability of potential sites. Obtains and develops house and repair plans, solicits appropriate professional construction help, creates list of needed building materials, and assists the Resource Development committee and staff in obtaining materials and volunteers and overseeing construction.
