About Us

Lebanon Area Habitat for Humanity (LAHFH) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit and affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, an ecumenical Christian housing ministry. Founded in 1993, LAHFH expanded in 2012 to serve Linn County ZIP Codes 97355, 97327, 97386, 97345, and 97329, adding nine homes in Sweet Home. To date, we have built 31 homes, with one currently under construction and another being renovated.

Our mission is to build and refurbish affordable homes for qualified buyers and to provide critical home repairs that help homeowners remain in their communities. Homes and repairs are not free—homeowners make affordable monthly payments based on costs and their ability to pay.

The Work / Programs and Services

Homeownership program provides new home construction for individuals and families who meet income requirements, based on annual HUD Income Limits 30-80% in Linn County, Oregon. Home repair and Preservation program offers simple to critical home services to homeowners to improve safety and accessibility. Certain manufactured and mobile home projects are also eligible. Income requirements are based on annual HUD Income Limits 30-80% in Linn County, Oregon. Check out the Programs page on our website to complete a Home Repair and Preservation Program Interest form and learn details about allowable projects.

Our **ReStore** sells wholesale donations from distributors or small stores due to overstock and leftover inventory and new and gently used items donated by our community. Items are sold at 35-50 percent off retail price. Along with paint and mixed metals recycling, we provide local donation pickup and product delivery services. Our website ReStore page lists what items can be donated and recycled. And our [online ReStore](#) offers a way to shop from home or “peek inside” our ReStore located at 566 S. Main Street in Lebanon to view our latest inventory. Hours: Thursday and Friday, 10am-5pm and Saturday, 10am-4pm.

- Executive (Board only: President, VP, Treasurer, and Secretary)

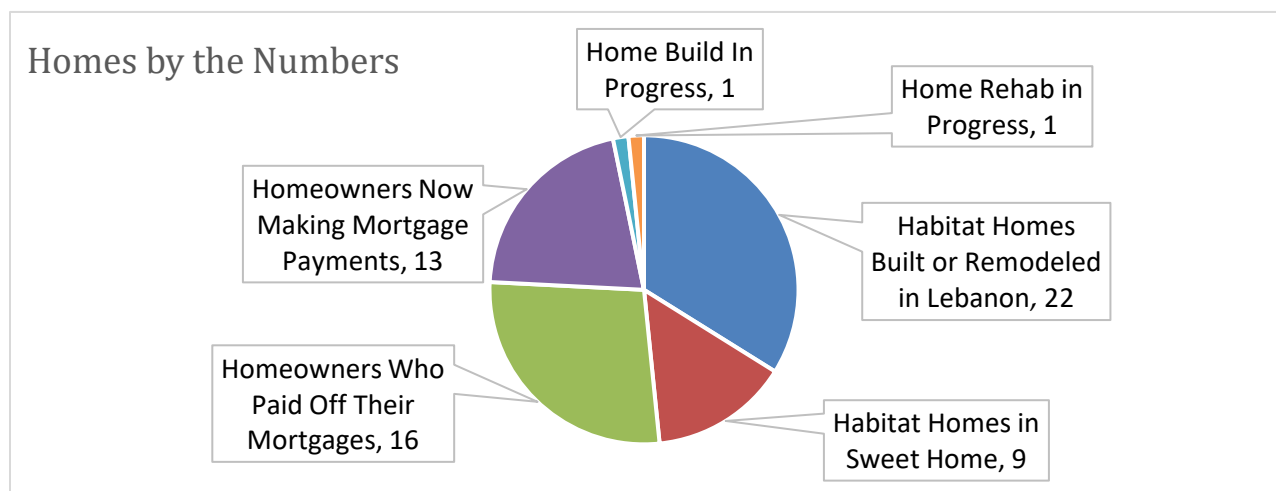
